- **School Recognition Money**
 - Dr. Grimm explained what School recognition money is. NDHS has received this money for 10 years straight. This year the school was awarded \$45,358. Dr. Grimm presented how the school would like to use the money:

- **Committees**
 - **Cultural Fest**- Update: The Cultural Fest will be April 2nd. NDHS has 22 nationalities representants at the school. The committee is in need of art supplies for students to draw/paint. Some examples include: Canvas, paint brushes, poster boards, and paint. Dr. Grimm advised that if students donate items, she would award community service items. She advised she will speak with Ms. Arguelles to create a rubric so hours are awarded based on items sent in.

We had tutoring going on and some of the student's younger siblings were working on their virtual assignments in the media lab. Next Homework Diner is set for December 3rd. A parent has volunteered to cater the diner for December. December's meal will be Spanish food.

 - Question about students attending SAC meeting. Dr. Grimm advised that students who attend the Title 1/SAC Meeting do receive 1 hour of volunteer hours. They must ensure they sign the sign in sheet so their attendance can be verified.
