**Welcome-** Mrs. Bhoj called the meeting to order at 6:08. She discussed the minutes from the previous SAC meeting. Mrs. Raymond motioned to approve the minutes, and Mrs. Boja seconded the motion. Mrs. Barret welcomed the parents and explained that our Social Studies and English departments created a Jeopardy style game for the parents and students to participate in at the end of our meeting.

### **PSAT-**

Mrs. Barrett informed parents that the sophomores took the PSAT on October 13<sup>th</sup> and that the scores are expected December 6<sup>th</sup>. She explained that the PSAT helps for students to know how they will perform on the SAT that they will take as juniors or seniors. She explained that the students can satisfy their Algebra 1 state requirement with a high enough concordant score on the PSAT.

### **Testing-**

Mrs. Barret explained that our next round of State End of Course testing will begin Monday November 29<sup>th</sup>. Students enrolled in Biology, US History, Government, Algebra 1, and Geometry will be testing. She explained that we give EOC at the end of each semester because we are on a 4x4 block schedule. Testing dates will be posted on the activity calendar and the students will receive a letter indicating when and what they will test. Biology and US History are not graduation requirements, but they score in factored in as their final exam and is worth 30% of their grade for the course. The district will input with scores. Civics is a new test that students must take. It is now a college requirement, but if the student scores high enough in high school, it satisfies the college requirement. Students must pass Algebra 1 with a 3 or higher as a graduation

requirement, however they can satisfy that requirement with a concordant score on the Geometry, PSAT, SAT or ACT.

#### Parent Engagement-

The Social Studies and English departments created a Jeopardy style game to highlight important facts and ideas that students learn in their classes. Parents and students played the game. The winner received a \$20 voucher, and the 2<sup>nd</sup> place winner received a \$10 voucher purchases in our Book Fair,
